

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to levying the property taxes of  
2 King County for the year 1972.

3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

4 SECTION 1. The County Assessor of King County has certified  
5 to the County Council that the assessed valuation of the County  
6 of King as finally equalized amounts to \$5,402,956,476.00, (20%  
7 only of watercraft) \$5,384,646,178.00.

8 SECTION 2. The Council of King County, Washington, finds  
9 that the amounts of the levies necessary to raise the amounts of  
10 the estimate expenditures as so finally determined for the year  
11 1972, less the total of estimated revenues from sources other than  
12 taxation, including available surplus, and such expenditures as  
13 are to be met from bond warrant issues, be and the same are hereby  
14 fixed as follows:
