

ORDINANCE

NO. 1068

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of South 216th Street (Military Road to 42nd Avenue South)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1: That the Director of the Department of Public Works has made an examination of South 216th Street (Military Road to 42nd Avenue South) along the course and description as set forth below, and had made a favorable report upon same, as required by law.

Section 2: That said road be established not less than 60 feet in width, having 30 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning on the E-W centerline of Section 10, Township 22 North, Range 4 East, W.M., at a point 491.77 feet easterly of the W 1/4 corner of said Section 10, said point being the intersection of Military Road and South 216th Street; thence in an easterly direction a distance of 4,281.94 feet to a terminus at engineer's station 42+90.00, said terminus being the centerline of 42nd Avenue S and also the center of Section 10, Township 22 North, Range 4 East, W.M.

4,281.94 Feet = .81 Miles

Section 3: That the King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.
