ORDINANCE  
NO 1081

An ORDINANCE providing for an appropriation transfer from the Special Programs to the Department of Public Safety in 1971 budget for costs related to underfunded Jail food and unanticipated unusual occurrences; and amending Section 2 of Ordinance 639

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1 The Department of Public Safety will experience a budget overrun of \$50,000 in its 1971 budget due to insufficient original appropriation for Jail food, and costs for unanticipated unusual occurrences, including Grand Jury and the Duvall Buffalo Party Rock Festival.

SECTION 2 The County Council finds as a fact that the Department of Public Safety has insufficient funds to meet the mandatory requirements for its services.

SECTION 3 The County Executive shall be and hereby is authorized to transfer \$50,000 of unexpended funds from Special Programs to the Department of Public Safety in the 1971 annual budget.

SECTION 4 The County Council hereby amends Ordinance 639, Section 2, as amended, to read as follows:

Department of Public Safety ((~~\$6,655,889~~)) \$6,705,889

Special Programs (( ~~\$2,881,293~~ )) \$2,831,293

SECTION 5 The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and this Ordinance is necessary for the

1 immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and  
2 the support of county government and its existing institutions.
