SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE  
NO. 1085

1 AN ORDINANCE establishing the compensation to  
2 be paid County officers and employees.

3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

4 SECTION 1. The compensation to be paid all officers and em-  
5 ployees of King County Executive and Judicial branches of govern-  
6 ment shall be those salary rates set forth in Ordinance No. 685  
7 as amended and in effect on December 31, 1971, provided that the  
8 compensation to be paid the below listed officers and employees  
9 shall not exceed the annual rates specified:

15 SECTION 2. The authority of the County Executive to correct  
16 clerical errors pursuant to the procedures outlined in Ordinance  
17 No. 465 shall be and is hereby extended to include the 1972  
18 budget and any salary and/or appropriation ordinances enacted  
19 pursuant thereto.

20 SECTION 3. Nothing herein shall limit the authority of the  
21 Manager, Office of Personnel, to reclassify any County officer  
22 or employee's position title and to establish salary payment  
23 procedures pursuant to Ordinance No. 422 and the "Administrative  
24 Procedures and Rules for the Career Service" approved August 28,  
25 1970, provided the salary rate for any officer or employee reclass-  
26 ified shall be the same as that established herein and shall not  
27 be changed by virtue of said reclassification until such time as  
28 a pay plan is adopted by ordinance.

29 SECTION 4. Due to the expansion of the County Auditor's  
30 responsibilities in the area of developing issue papers, making  
31 special research studies, and carrying on liaison work with the  
32 State legislature, the salary of that office is hereby raised to  
\$22,500.

SECTION 5. There shall be established in the office of County Assessor a new position of Administrative Assistant at a yearly salary of \$22,500.00; Provided, however, that nothing in this section shall be construed to increase the total budget of the Assessor's Office.
