

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to setting a date of election for
2 annexation of territory to Lakehaven Sewer District.

3 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

4 SECTION 1. A petition was filed with the King County
5 Executive by the Commissioners of Lakehaven Sewer District for the
6 annexation of territory hereinafter described, and known as North
7 Lake, to said Lakehaven Sewer District, and the petition was sub-
8 mitted to the Superintendent of Elections.

9 SECTION 2. The Superintendent of Elections has filed with the
10 King County Executive said petition together with his certificate
11 stating that the petition has been examined and found to contain a
12 sufficient number of signatures of qualified electors residing with-
13 in the territory proposed to be annexed, and the County Executive
14 has submitted said petition and Certificate of Sufficiency to the
15 King County Council.

16 SECTION 3. The King County Council has fixed the 3rd day
17 of January, 1972, as the date of hearing on said
18 petition and has caused Notice of Hearing to be published in
19 accordance with the law, and hearing has been held on said date.

20 SECTION 4. Said proposed annexation of territory to Lakehaven
21 Sewer District will be conducive to the public health, welfare and
22 convenience and will be of special benefit to the land included
23 within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed.

24 SECTION 5. A special election shall be held on the 29th day
25 of February, 1972, within the territory of the pro-
26 posed annexation as hereinafter described, between the hours of
27 8:00 o'clock A.M. and 8:00 o'clock P.M., for the purpose of
28 submitting to the qualified electors within the territory proposed
29 to be annexed the proposition of annexing said territory to
30 Lakehaven Sewer District.

31 SECTION 6. The boundaries of the territory to be annexed to
32 Lakehaven Sewer District are hereby described as follows:

1 Beginning at the NW corner of Section 15, Township 21
2 North, Range 4 E., W.M., in King County, Washington;

3 Thence Easterly along the North line of the West $\frac{1}{2}$ of
4 said Section 15 to its intersection with the centerline
5 of Military Road South;

6 Thence Southerly along the centerline of said Military
7 Road South to its intersection with the E-W centerline
8 of said Section 15;

9 Thence Westerly along said E-W centerline to its inter-
10 section with the N-S centerline of said Section 15;

11 Thence South along said N-S centerline to the South
12 quarter corner of Section 15, also being the North
13 quarter corner of Section 22, Township 21 North, Range
14 4 East, W.M.;

15 Thence continuing South along the N-S centerline of
16 said Section 22 to its intersection with the centerline
17 of Primary State Highway No. 2 (SR 18);

18 Thence Southwesterly along the centerline of said
19 Primary State Highway No. 2 to its intersection with
20 the East line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section
21 22;

22 Thence North along said East line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the
23 NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the East line of Government Lot 1 to its
24 intersection with the North line of the South 300 feet
25 of Government Lot 1 in said Section 22;

26 Thence Westerly along said North line of the South 300
27 feet to its intersection with the West line of said
28 Section 22;

29 Thence North along said West line to the NW corner of
30 said Section 22, also being the SW corner of said
31 Section 15;

32 Thence continuing North along the West line of said
Section 15 to the Northwest corner thereof and the
point of beginning.

SECTION 7. In submitting said proposition to the voters for
their approval or rejection, said proposition shall be expressed on
the ballot in the following terms:

For Annexation to Lakehaven Sewer District
Against Annexation to Lakehaven Sewer District

SECTION 8. Notice of election shall be published as required
by law.

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INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 27th day of December, 1971.
