

ORDINANCE  
NO. 1097

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of  
Echo Lake - Snoqualmie Cutoff (Lake Alice  
Road Extension to SR 202)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1: That the Director of the Department of Public  
Works has made an examination of Echo Lake - Snoqualmie Cutoff  
(Lake Alice Road Extension to SR 202) along the course and  
description as set forth below, and had made a favorable report  
upon same, as required by law.

Section 2: That said road be established not less than  
84 feet in width, having 42 feet of such width each side of the  
following described centerline:

Beginning in the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 35, Township  
24 North, Range 7 East, W.M. at Engineers Station 56+43.91  
of King County, Survey No. 2-23-7-5, thence in a NE'ly  
direction a distance of 13,187.20 feet to a terminus on  
the centerline of SR 202 at Engineers Station 1383+75.46  
of State Highway Survey of said SR 202, said terminus  
being S 15° 36' 30" E. a distance of 274.40 feet, thence  
S 25° 38' 30" E. a distance of 327.76 feet from the south  
end of State Highway Bridge No. SR 202/60 crossing the  
Snoqualmie River.

13,187.20 Feet - 2.50 Miles

Section 3: That the King County Council finds that the  
establishment of said roadway, along the course and description  
set forth, is a public necessity.
