

NO. ORDINANCE  
1108

1 AN ORDINANCE acknowledging unanticipated revenue  
2 from Federal and State grants for various projects,  
3 appropriating said revenue to the General Grant  
4 Fund in the King County 1972 Budget.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1. The County Council acknowledges that unantic-  
7 ipated revenue in the amount of \$870,917.34, will be received as  
8 reimbursement for various projects to be administered by the  
9 County.

10 SECTION 2. A supplemental appropriation in the amount  
11 specified in Section 1 herein, is hereby approved and appropriated  
12 to the General Grant Fund for the following projects:

25 SECTION 3. Funds appropriated in Section 2, herein,  
26 shall not be expended for purposes other than specified guide-  
27 lines stipulated by the Federal and State granting agencies.

28 SECTION 4. The County Council finds as a fact and  
29 declares that an emergency exists and this Ordinance is necessary  
30 for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and  
31 safety, and the support of County government and its existing  
32 institutions.
