

SUBSTITUTE ORDINANCE
NO. 1132

AN ORDINANCE amending King County Zoning Code Resolution No. 25789, as amended, by amending the Zoning Map thereof reclassifying certain property thereon at the request of

J.L. HENDERSON,
Department of Planning File No. P 70-49.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY

SECTION 1. J.L. Henderson petitioned February 12, 1970 that the property described in Section 3 below be reclassified from RS 15,000 and G to M-L and this application was assigned Department of Planning File No. P 70-49.

SECTION 2. The report and recommendation of the Department of Planning was transmitted to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on September 11, 1970 and hearing was held by the Examiner on this matter September 22, 1970. The attached report of the Examiner was filed with the Clerk of the Council October 9, 1970.

SECTION 3. The legal description of the property to be reclassified is attached as Appendix A and is hereby made a part of this ordinance. The above described property is shown on the attached map, which is designated as Appendix B and is hereby made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. The King County Council does hereby amend the King County Zoning Code, Resolution No. 25789 by reclassifying that property described and shown in Section 3, Appendices A and B above, to M-L and directs that Area Maps 27-26-5 and E-22-26-5 be modified to so designate.
