

ORDINANCE NO. 1467

AN ORDINANCE relating to levying the property taxes of certain districts of King County for the year 1973 amending Ordinance No. 1430, Section 2, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1430, Section 2, as amended by Ordinance No. 1432, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2. The Council of King County, Washington, finds that the amounts of the levies necessary to raise the amounts of the estimated expenditures as so finally determined for the year 1973, less the total of estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including available surplus, and such expenditures as are to be met from bond warrant issues, be and the same are hereby fixed as follows:
