STANDING COMMITTEES. The Chairman of the Council shall appoint the Chairman, Vice Chairman and the membership of the standing committees, with consent of a majority of the Council members.

Function: to consider and make recommendations on all matters and legislation of a financial nature, including appropriations,

13	oversee and receive reports from the Office of Citizens: Complaint
14	and the County Auditor; to consider and make recommendations on
15	all matters relating to county records and elections; to consider
16	and make recommendations relating to amendment of the County
17	Charter.
18	6) Public Works and Transportation - ((Five)) Four or

20	Function: to consider and make recommendations on all matters
21	pertaining to the construction and maintenance of the County road
22	system and other transportation facilities, and on all matters
23	pertaining to other County construction, solid waste, public
24	works, and utilities.
25	SECTION 2. The committee chairman has option of declaring
26	no quorum or selecting another councilman to serve on the committee
27	as a protem member, if in need of a quorum. In the absence of
28	the Chairman and Vice Chairman of a committee, a committee member
29	may be appointed by the committee chairman to serve as chairman
30	for that monting

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares 1 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for 2 the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or 3 for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
