

ORDINANCE NO. 1780

AN ORDINANCE relating to the established 1973 rates of compensation to be paid officers and employees of County government not included in collective bargaining agreements, amending Ordinance No. 1472, Section 3, 4, and 5, and Ordinance No. 1282, Section 5.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

 23 SECTION 4 herein. Provided further, any pay range adjustments for

 25 five or more pay ranges for any existing classification shall be

28 SECTION 5. NEW SECTION. There is added a new section to Or-
 29 dinance 1282 to read as follows:

30 in construing the provisions of this ordinance, except where other-
 31 wise plainly declared or clearly apparent from the context, words
 32 used herein shall be given their common and ordinary meaning; in
 33 addition, the following definitions shall apply:

1 (1) PAY PLAN - A systematic schedule of numbered pay ranges
2 with the minimum, maximum, and intermediate steps for each pay
3 range. Each classification is assigned to a numbered payrange
4 within the schedule.

5 (2) POSITION - A group of current duties and responsibilities
6 assigned by competent authority requiring the full-time or part-
7 time employment of one person.

8 (3) CLASSIFICATION PLAN - The arrangement of positions into
9 classes together with specifications describing each class.

10 (4) CLASSIFICATION - A position or group of positions, estab-
11 lished by authority, being sufficiently similar in respect to the
12 duties, responsibilities, and authority thereof, that the same
13 descriptive title may be used to designate each position allocated
14 to the class.

15 (5) NEW CLASSIFICATION - A new classification is required be-
16 cause factors of an existing classification can not be applied to
17 a position or group of positions.

18 (6) RECLASSIFICATION - A change in the classification of a
19 position to a higher, lower, or equivalent class on the basis of
20 significant changes in the kind, difficulty, and responsibility of
21 duties assigned by competent authority.

22 (7) SALARY OR PAY RATE - An individual dollar amount which
23 is one of the steps in a pay range paid to an employee based on
24 the classification of the position occupied.

25 (8) SALARY OR PAY RANGE - One or more pay rates representing
26 the minimum, maximum, and intermediate steps assigned to a classi-
27 fication.


28 (9) PAY RANGE ADJUSTMENT - The adjustment of the numbered pay
29 range of a class to another numbered pay range in the schedule
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1 based on a class concept change, competitive pay data, or other
2 significant factors.




