ORDINANCE NO. 1785

1 AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$200,500 to the
2 Grant Fund from the Federal Law Enforcement Administration
3 Association for the Residential Burglary Prevention
4 Project, recognizing a cash match of \$35,729 from the
Department of Public Safety, Current Expense Fund, for
support of the project, and amending Ordinance No. 1431,
Section 3, as amended.

5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1. The amount of \$200,500 is hereby appropriated to the Grant
7 Fund from the Federal Law Enforcement Administration Association, Grant No.
8 1122, for the Residential Burglary Prevention Project, County File No. 332.

9 SECTION 2. The amount of \$35,729 is hereby recognized as the cash
10 match requirement for the Residential Burglary Prevention Project, County
11 File No. 332, Federal Law Enforcement Administration Association, Grant No.
12 1122, from the Department of Public Safety, Current Expense Fund.

13 SECTION 3. The Council of King County acknowledges and In-kind contri-
14 bution of \$31,104 from the Department of Public Safety in support of the
15 Residential Burglary Prevention Project, County File No. 332, Federal Law
16 Enforcement Administration Association, Grant No. 1122.
