AN ORDINANCE relating to Rules and Order of Business of the King County Council, amending Ordinance 1373, Section 7 and Section 8, K.C.C. 1.24.070 and 1.24.080.

PREAMBLE: Motion No. 1237 establishes the office of the Clerk of the Council and the scope of authority includes duties given to the Administrator-Clerk by K.C.C. 1.24.070 and 1.24.080.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1373, Section 7, and K.C.C. 1.24.070 are hereby amended as follows:

LEGAL SIGNATURES. All official documents issued by order of the Council shall be under the hand of the Chairman or in his absence the acting Chairman and attested by the ((Administrator Clerk,)) Clerk of the Council, except as otherwise provided by the Charter.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 1373, Section 8; and K.C.C. 1.24.080 are hereby amended as follows:

INITIAL PROCESSING - ORDINANCES AND MOTIONS. Ordinances and motions shall be drafted in conformance with drafting guide lines prepared by the office of the ((Administrator-Clerk)) Clerk of the Council.

Proposed ordinances or motions must be filed with the ((Administrator-Clerk)) Clerk of the Council and introduced by Council member.

INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 4th day of September, 1973.
