

ORDINANCE NO. 1815

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area
2 known as the #69-24 Annexation Area to Southwest
3 Suburban Sewer District.

4 WHEREAS, Southwest Suburban Sewer District, King County, has
5 found the petition for annexation of an area known as the #69-24
6 Annexation Area to be sufficient and has, by resolution, con-
7 curred with the proposed annexation; and

8 WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed an-
9 nexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary
10 Review Board; and

11 WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is
12 in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county
13 comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan
14 for sewer facilities;

15 THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

16 SECTION 1. The annexation by Southwest Suburban Sewer
17 District, King County, of the area known as the #69-24 Annexation
18 Area and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

19 SECTION 2. The area known as the #69.24 Annexation Area to
20 be annexed is described as follows:

21 Beginning at the Southwest corner of the SE 1/4 of Section
22 20, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M.;

23 Thence Northerly along the West line of the said SE 1/4 to
24 its intersection with the centerline of Renton-Three Tree
Point Road as established by King County Survey 2649;

25 Thence Easterly along said centerline to its intersection
26 with the East line of the West 660 feet of the said SE 1/4;

1 Thence Southerly along said East line to its intersection
2 with the South line of the said SE 1/4 (Centerline of S.
160th St.);


3 Thence Westerly along said South line to the said Southwest
4 corner of the SE 1/4 and the Point of Beginning.
