

ORDINANCE NO. 1821'

1  
2 AN ORDINANCE relating to reorganization and  
3 consolidation of King County Departments and  
4 Administrative Offices and amending Ordinance  
5 No. 1438, Section 3, Subsection (a) and Sub-  
6 section (3), and K.C.C. 2.16.040 and K.C.C.  
7 2.16.080, and adding a new section.

8 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

9 SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1438, Section 3, Subsection (a) and  
10 K.C.C. 2.16.040 are hereby amended to read as follows:

11 Department of public works and transportation -- Duties --  
12 Divisions. The department of public works and transportation shall be  
13 responsible for the administration of the divisions of engineering, solid  
14 waste, airport, hydraulics, other related utility, public works and trans-  
15 portation functions. The department shall be composed of the following  
16 divisions:

17 (1) ENGINEERING DIVISION. The engineering division shall be  
18 responsible for the administration of the county roads and streets system,  
19 including road/street design, construction, ((and)) maintenance programs,  
20 and the administration and operation of Engineering and Central Automotive  
21 functions.

22 (2) AIRPORT DIVISION. The airport division shall be responsi-  
23 ble for the administration of King County Airport(s), including the implemen-  
24 tation of county policy regarding airport development, the enforcement of  
25 King County Code rules and regulations regarding airport operations, and the  
26 administration of the fiscal and operating activities of county airport(s).

27 (3) SOLID WASTE DIVISION. The solid waste division shall be  
28 responsible for the administration of the county solid waste program which  
29 provides for the disposal and recycling of solid waste for King County  
30 households and industries.

31 (4) HYDRAULICS DIVISION. The hydraulics division shall be  
32 responsible for the administration of county surface water management pro-  
33 grams, including construction and maintenance programs which implement county  
policy as it relates to the regulation of drainage and the prevention of  
floods.

1                    SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1438, Section 3, Subsection (3) and  
2 K.C.C. 2.16.080 are hereby amended to read as follows:

3                    Department of executive administration -- Divisions. The  
4 department of executive administration shall be under the direction of the  
5 county administrative officer and shall include the following:

6                    (1) COMPTROLLER DIVISION. The comptroller division shall pre-  
7 scribe the accounting procedures to be used by the county after coordination  
8 with the budget division, shall collect all county revenue and shall make all  
9 disbursements, and investment of county funds.

10                   (2) PERSONNEL DIVISION. The personnel division shall have the  
11 responsibilities established by Article 5 of the Charter and shall perform  
12 any other duties assigned to it by the county administrative officer.

13                   (3) SYSTEMS SERVICES DIVISION. The systems services division  
14 shall establish and maintain a modern system for processing information in  
15 accordance with the needs of county government.

16                   (4) PROPERTY AND PURCHASING DIVISION. The property and pur-  
17 chasing division shall assign the use of all real and personal property  
18 owned or leased by the county, shall maintain all property unless its main-  
19 tenance is otherwise assigned by the Charter, by ordinance, or by the county  
20 executive, shall negotiate the lease or sale of county property, shall con-  
21 tract for all services and public works which are not performed by county  
22 employees and shall purchase all real and personal property purchased by the  
23 county.

24                   (5) RECORDS AND ELECTIONS DIVISION. The records and elections  
25 division shall record, file and register all documents presented to it which  
26 by general law may be recorded, filed and registered to provide constructive  
27 legal notice and all other documents specified by ordinance; shall maintain  
28 the county archives to store all county records which should not be destroyed  
29 and which are not necessary for the current operation of county government;  
30 shall be responsible for the registration of voters in the county; and shall  
31 conduct all special and general elections held in the county.

32                   (6) GENERAL SERVICES DIVISION. The general services division  
33

1 shall administer regulations of the county requiring business, motor vehicle,  
2 and marriage licenses, shall administer functions related to licensing,  
3 veterans, and control of animals, and other functions assigned by the county  
4 administrative officer.

5 ((FACILITIES-AND-AUTOMOTIVE-SERVICES-DIVISION))

6 (7) FACILITIES MANAGEMENT DIVISION. The facilities ((and  
7 automotive-services)) management division shall be responsible for the manage-  
8 ment of county facilities and ((the-operation-of-central-automotive-functions))  
9 provide management in the King County Automotive Center.

10 SECTION 3.-- NEW SECTION. The effective date of this ordinance  
11 shall be January 1, 1974.
