

ORDINANCE NO. 1842

AN ORDINANCE relating to licensing private security agencies and amending K.C.C. 6.24.050 and Section 5, Ordinance 1492.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. K.C.C. 6.24.050 and Section 5, Ordinance 1492 are each amended to read as follows:

The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to:

(a) A person employed (~~exclusively-and-regularly~~) as an in-house guard and/or investigator by only one employer in connection with the affairs of such employer (~~only~~) and where there exists an employer-employee relationship;

(b) An officer or employee of the United States of America, or of this State or a political subdivision thereof, while the employee or officer is engaged in the performance of official duties;

(c) A person engaged exclusively in the business of obtaining and furnishing information in relation to the financial rating of persons.

(d) An attorney-at-law in performing his duties;


(e) Admitted insurers, agents, and insurance brokers,

2 insurance transacted by them.




