

ORDINANCE NO. 1852

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$73,210 to the Mental Health-Mental Retardation Fund allocated to King County by the State Department of Social and Health Services, amending Ordinance No. 1431, Section 3, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$73,210 is hereby appropriated to the Mental Health-Mental Retardation Fund for support of community mental health programs in King County, \$7,500 of which is a once only allocation for expansion of mental health services and \$65,710 is to begin development of an admission reduction program for people previously sent to state mental institutions.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1431, Section 3, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:




