1 ORDINANCE NO. 1864

2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the withdrawal of an
3 area known as Upper Woodmont from Des Moines
 Sewer District.

4 WHEREAS, Des Moines Sewer District has found the petition
5 for withdrawal of an area known as Upper Woodmont to be suffi-
6 cient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed with-
7 drawal; and

8 WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed with-
9 drawal by the King County Council and the King County Boundary
10 Review Board; and

11 WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said withdrawal is
12 in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county
13 comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county
14 sewer facilities;

15 THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

16 SECTION 1. The withdrawal from Des Moines Sewer District
17 of the area known as Upper Woodmont and described in Section 2
18 herein is approved.


1 SECTION 2. The area known as Upper Woodmont to be with-

7 State Highway No. 1-V, also known as Puget
8 Sound Marine View Drive, and Easterly of a
9 line 150 feet Westerly of and parallel to,
10 the Westerly margin of said Secondary State
11 Highway.




