

ORDINANCE NO. 1884

1 AN ORDINANCE appropriating E.D.P. New Systems
2 Development funds totaling \$81,593 to various
3 departments, amending Ordinance No. 1431,
4 Section 2, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

5 The King County Data Processing Review Committee has, during
6 the period September 1, 1973, to December 31, 1973, approved E.D.P. new
7 systems development activities totaling \$81,593. The funds provided
8 from Special Programs by this ordinance are to be utilized for these
9 approved systems development activities.

10 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

11 SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1431, Section 2, as amended is hereby
12 amended to read as follows:
