

ORDINANCE NO. 1901

AN ORDINANCE relating to 911 emergency notification systems amending Ordinance No. 1358, Section 4 and adding a new section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1358, Section 4 is hereby amended to read as follows:

King County shall provide to ~~((these municipalities who are not desirous of becoming a cooperating participant in the 911 system))~~ municipal corporations one direct line ~~((into))~~ from the 911 emergency center for police and fire protection. This line shall be at the expense of the county.

SECTION 2. NEW SECTION. There is added to Ordinance No. 1358 a new section to read as follows:

In order to encourage intergovernmental cooperation, the County Executive is authorized to negotiate agreements with municipal corporations who combine their emergency dispatching into one dispatching center whereby the county may fund multiple lines where it is mutually cost effective as related to Section 1 above.
