

PROPOSED ORDINANCE
NO. 1920

AN ORDINANCE relating to the County Capital Budget and program revising the 1974 Park Capital Improvement Sub-Program Budget; amending Ordinance No. 1859, Section 8, Attachment 1, as amended, to appropriate \$5,500 unanticipated revenue for Kent Neighborhood Park #5.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$5,500 for Kent Neighborhood Park #5, unanticipated revenue in the form of a reimbursement from the Park Orchard Community Club.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1859, Section 7, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:





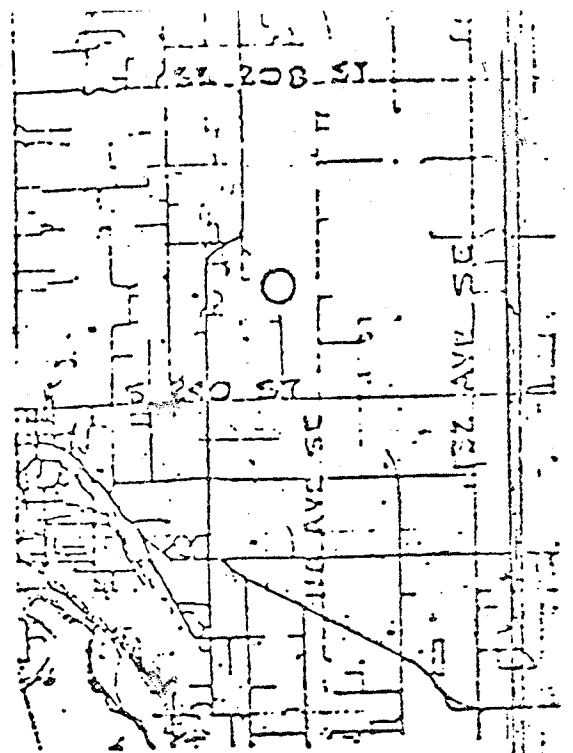
