ORDINANCE NO. 1933

AN ORDINANCE relating to levying the property taxes of certain districts of King County for the year 1974 and amending Ordinance 1885, Section 2, and adding a new section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1885, Section 2, is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Council of King County, Washington, finds that the amounts of the levies necessary to raise the amounts of the estimated expenditures as so finally determined for the year 1974, less the total of estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including available surplus, and such expenditures as are to be met from bond warrant issues, be and the same are hereby fixed as follows:



The levies herein are fixed and adopted based on the certification of the King County Assessor that the assessed valuation of the County of King as finally equalized amounts to \$7,210,856,674, (20% only of watercraft) \$7,206,373,152. These stated assessed valuations shall be used as the legal basis for application of any legal restrictions on tax levies in future years.
