ORDINANCE NO. 1939

AN ORDINANCE recognizing unanticipated revenue of \$32,000 from the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services to aid in funding of Methadone Maintenance programs, granting a supplemental appropriation to the Mental Health-Mental Retardation Fund, amending Ordinance No. 1859.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The County Council hereby acknowledges that unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$32,000 has been awarded to King County by the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services to aid in funding of Methadone Maintenance programs.

SECTION 2. A supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$32,000, as specified in Section 1, herein, is hereby approved and adopted to the Mental Health-Mental Retardation-Drug Abuse Division in the Mental Health Mental Retardation Fund.


SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 1859, Section 3, is hereby amended to read as follows:


