ation of the granting of right-of-way for the proposed N.E. 124th Street and N. E. 128th Street project (R/W 2000), and WHEREAS, the report of the Department of Public Works and Transportation and the Department of Community and Environmental Development,

Land Use Management Division, finds that the road to be vacated is useless to the County and the vacation would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the comprehensive plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of the proposed vacation, and

WHEREAS, the petitioner has agreed, as consideration for the subject vacation, to deed a portion of right-of-way required for the N. E. 124th Street and N. E. 128th Street project (R/W 2000), said portion described as follows:

That portion of Government Lot 2 in the Northwest & of Section 30, Township 26 North, Range 6 East, W.M., LESS county road (C.O. Pearson Road.): Included within a strip of land 100 feet in width, being 50 feet on each side of the following described line: Beginning in Section 26, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington, at a point on the centerline of S.R.522 (Rev. Cook Road #26-26-5-7), said point being the center of said Section 26; Thence South 88°06'41" East a distance of 1713.17 feet; Thence on the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 1430.00 feet a distance of 481.69 feet; Thence North 72°35'19" East a distance of 253.07 feet; Thence on the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 1150.00 feet a distance of 305.75 feet; Thence North 87°49'19" East a distance of 205.04 feet; Thence on the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 1150.00 feet a distance of 475.47 feet; Thence North 64°07'59" East a distance of 1717.17 feet; Thence on the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 1430.00 feet a distance of 678.64 feet; Thence South 88°40'33" East a distance of 2357.72 feet; Thence South 85°26'40" East a distance of 1020.65 feet; Thence on the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 820.00 feet a distance of 568.55 feet; Thence North 54°49'46" East a distance of 247.82 feet; Thence on the arc of a curve to the right having a radius of 820.00 feet a distance of 568.86 feet; Thence South 85°25'21" East a distance of 382.36 feet to a terminus at the centerline intersection of N. E. 128th Street and Redmond-Avondale Road; said terminus bearing North 6°26'26" East a distance of 113.96 feet from K.C.M. J 11.

15	within the East half of the S.E. & of the N.E. & of Section
16	25, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., EXCEPT the North 50 feet thereof. ALSO all that portion of said C.O.
17	Pearson Road right-of-way lying within the S.W.表 of the N.W.表 of Section 30, Township 26 North, Range 6 East, W.M.
