ORDINANCE  
NO. 1985

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to solid waste disposal  
2 operations; amending Section 2 and Section 3,  
3 Ordinance 800 and KCC 10.12.030.

4 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

5 SECTION 1. Section 2, Part 1.c., Ordinance 800 and KCC  
6 10.12.030 is amended to read as follows:

7 The minimum fee per ((vehiele)) passenger car shall be  
8 \$0.75 at transfer stations and \$0.50 at final disposal sites.

9 SECTION 2. Section 3, Ordinance 800 and KCC 10.12.030  
10 is amended to read as follows:

11 All service fees collected pursuant to this ordinance  
12 shall be collected in cash by site cashiers at the time of use;  
13 provided, that the ((Superintendent)) Manager of the King County  
14 Solid Waste Division, Department of Public Works  
15 and Transportation may authorize a commercial or non-commercial  
16 user to be billed monthly for all solid waste delivered to  
17 the transfer stations and/or final disposal sites.

18 Authorization of a commercial or non-commercial user's  
19 monthly billing shall result from a request in advance for  
20 such service by the commercial or non-commercial user provided,  
21 that no authorization shall be granted without the posting of  
22 an irrevocable payment bond secured by the commercial or non-  
23 commercial user in the name of the Solid Waste Division and in  
24 an amount which is equal to the ((estimated monthly usage charge))  
25 actual prior three months of user fee charges. In the absence  
26 of prior usage charges, an estimate by the commercial or non-  
27 commercial user of three months of usage charges will determine  
28 the bond amount. The amount of such bond may be changed by  
29 giving of thirty day notice by the ((Superintendent)) Manager  
30 to reflect actual usage.

31 All invoiced fees shall be due and payable to King County,  
32 Solid Waste Division, in monthly installments on or before the  
33 ((tenth day)) last day of each billing month. A late charge

equal to the legal rate of interest shall be assessed on the delinquent unpaid balance of those non-governmental commercial and non-commercial accounts in arrears. The ((Superintendent)) Manager, having given seven days notice, may suspend use privileges for a commercial or non-commercial user who fails to tender payment within ((that time period)) two months in arrears.

A non-commercial user may be authorized by the ((Superintendent)) Manager to be billed monthly for all solid waste delivered to the transfer stations and for final disposal sites, provided that such non-commercial user is either (1) a municipal corporation, governmental department, agency or commission, or political subdivision; or (2) a person whose monthly service charges exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
