ORDINANCE NO. 1991

2 AN ORDINANCE re-establishing the King County
3 Arts Commission, defining the duties and
4 functions of such commission, increasing the
5 number of members, and repealing Ordinance
6 No. 733 and K.C.C. 2.48.010 through 2.48.070.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL:

8 SECTION 1. There is hereby re-established an arts commis-
9 sion to be known as "King County Arts Commission".

10 SECTION 2. The arts commission may, alone or in cooperation
11 with any other private, civic or public body of any city, county
12 or the State of Washington, initiate, sponsor or conduct programs
13 calculated to further public awareness of and interest in the
14 visual and performing arts.

15 SECTION 3. The membership of the arts commission shall be
16 increased from twelve (12) to sixteen (16) members, to be
17 appointed by the county executive with the approval of the
18 county council. Such appointive positions shall be for three
19 years respectively, provided that, initial appointments of the
20 additional four (4) members shall expire on December 15, 1976.
21 Vacancies on the arts commission shall be filled in the same
22 manner as described herein; provided further, that one member of
23 the county council shall be appointed annually to serve as an
24 ex officio member of the arts commission.

25 SECTION 4. The arts commission shall elect its officers,
26 including a chairman, vice chairman, and such other officers as
27 it may deem necessary. Such persons shall occupy their respec-
28 tive offices for a period of one year. The arts commission shall
29 hold regular public meetings at least monthly.

30 SECTION 5. The arts commission shall adopt rules for
31 transaction of business and shall keep a written record of its
32 proceedings which shall be a public record.

33 SECTION 6. The arts commission shall each year submit to
the county executive and county council for approval a proposed
budget for the following year in the manner provided by law for

1 the preparation and submission of budgets by appointive county
2 officials.

3 SECTION 7. The arts commission shall establish a fund into
4 which shall be placed the allocation as the county executive and
5 county council shall annually appropriate thereto together with
6 any miscellaneous revenues, grants, gifts or bequests for pur-
7 poses of furthering the arts. All expenditures shall be dis-
8 bursed from this fund by the arts commission and all balances
9 remaining in this fund at the end of any year shall be carried
10 over to the succeeding year.


11 SECTION 8. If any provision of this act or the operation of
12 such provision should be held invalid, such invalidity shall not
13 affect other provisions of this act or their operation unless
14 dependent for their effect or operation upon the provision held
15 invalid and then only to the extent of such dependency and for
16 such purpose the provisions of this act are declared to be
17 severable.

18 SECTION 9. NEW SECTION. Ordinance No. 733 and K.C.C.
19 2.48.010 through 2.48.070 are each hereby repealed.


