

ORDINANCE NO. 2002

1
2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an
3 area known as Jones to Des Moines Sewer
4 District.

5 WHEREAS, Des Moines Sewer District has found the petition
6 for annexation of an area known as Jones to be sufficient and
7 has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

8 WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed
9 annexation by the King County Council and the King County Bound-
10 ary Review Board; and

11 WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is
12 in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county
13 comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan
14 for sewer facilities;

15 THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

16 SECTION 1. The annexation by Des Moines Sewer District of
17 the area known as Jones and described in Section 2 herein is
18 approved.

19 SECTION 2. The area known as Jones to be annexed is
20 described as follows:

21 Beginning at the intersection of the North line of the
22 NE 1/4 of Section 20, Township 22 North, Range 4 East,
23 W.M., with the centerline of Railroad St. (10th Ave. S.)
24 of Des Moines Water Front Addition to the Town of Des
25 Moines, according to plat thereof recorded in volume 4
26 of plats, page 96, records of King County, Washington.

27 Thence Southerly along said centerline to its inter-
28 section with the centerline of Washington Ave.
29 (S. 242nd St.) as shown on said plat,

30 Thence Westerly along said centerline to its inter-
31 section with the centerline of Marine View Drive,


32 Thence Northerly along said centerline to its inter-
33 section with the said North line of the NE 1/4,

Thence Easterly along said North line to its inter-
section with the centerline of said Railroad St.
(10th Ave. S.) and the Point of Beginning.




