

ORDINANCE NO. 2022

AN ORDINANCE establishing a no-shooting area in the Lake Youngs Reservation and adding new section to K.C.C. 12.68.

PREAMBLE:

Under the provisions of RCW 36.20.120 the King County Council may make and enforce by ordinance, all such police regulations as are not in conflict with state law. The City of Seattle has requested the county to create a no-shooting area in the city-owned land known as Lake Youngs Reservation. The King County Council finds that it is in the public interest and safety to create such an area.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. NEW SECTION.

A new section is added to K.C.C. 12.68 to read as follows:

The shooting of firearms is hereby prohibited in the Lake Youngs Reservation described as:

"S $\frac{1}{2}$, Sec.35; W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$, of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 36; all in T23N, R5E, WM. Sec. 1 except Govt. Lots 1 and 2 and except E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and except any of remainder of said Section lying NEly of Petrovitsky Rd. SE; Sec. 2; Sec. 11 except SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and except SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$; Sec. 12 except SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and except S $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and except SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$; all in T22N, R5E, WM. Por. Govt. Lot 6 lying SWly of Petrovitsky Rd. SE and all of Govt. Lot 7, Sec. 6; Govt. Lot 1, Sec. 7; all in T22N, R6E, WM."
