ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the withdrawal of areas known as Parcel Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 4 from King County Water District No. 43.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 43 has found the petitions for withdrawal of areas known as Parcel Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 4 to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed withdrawal; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed withdrawal by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said withdrawal is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan for water facilities;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The withdrawal by King County Water District
No. 43 of areas known as Parcel Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 4 and described
in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The areas known as Parcel Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 4 to be withdrawn are described as follows:

## Parcel 1

That portion of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 16, T23N, R4E, W.M., in King County, Washington, and of the plat of Park Village, as recorded in volume 38 of Plats, page 9, records of said county, described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 9, Block 1, said Park Village; thence easterly along the north line of said Lot 9 and its easterly extension to the centerline of 16th Place South; thence northerly along said centerline to the westerly extension of the north line of Lot 3, Block 3, said Park Village; thence easterly along said extension and north line and along the north line of Lots 29 through 36, said Block 3, and its easterly extension, to the centerline of 20th Avenue South; thence northerly along said centerline to the centerline of South 135th Street; thence westerly along said centerline to the centerline of 16th Place South; thence northerly along said centerline to the easterly extension of the north line of Lot 6, aforesaid Block 1; thence westerly along said extension and north line to the west line of said Block 1; thence southerly along said west line to the Point of Beginning.

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## Parcel 2

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That portion of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section 16, T23N, R4E, W.M., in King County, Washington, and of Block D, J.F. Ord's Home Tracts, according to plat thereof recorded in volume 20 of Plats, page 11, records of said county, described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the westerly extension of the south line of the north 50 feet of Lot 11, said Block D, with the centerline of 20th Avenue South; thence easterly along said westerly extension and south line to the west line of Lot 8, said Block D; thence southerly along said west line of Lot 8 to the southwest corner thereof; thence easterly along the south line of said Lot 8 to the southeast corner thereof; thence northerly along the east line of said Lot 8 to the north line of the south 80 feet of Lot 6, said Block D; thence easterly along said north line to the west line of Lot 2, said Block D; thence northerly along said west line to the north line of said Lot 2; thence easterly along said north line and its easterly extension to the centerline of 22nd Avenue South; thence northerly along said centerline to the centerline of South 134th Street; westerly along said centerline to the centerline of 20th Avenue South; thence southerly along said centerline to the Point of Beginning.

## Parcel 3

That portion of the east half of the northwest quarter of section 16, T23N, R4E, W.M., in King County, Washington, and of Block A, J.F. Ord's Home Tracts, according to plat thereof recorded in volume 20 of plats, page 11, records of said county, and of Tract 4, Nichol's Garden Tracts Div. No. 2, according to plat thereof recorded in volume 11 of plats, page 35, records of said county, and of Jackson's Home Sites, according to plat thereof recorded in volume 41 of plats, page 33, records of said county, described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of 22nd Avenue South with the westerly extension of the north line of the south 80 feet of Lot 14, Block A, said J.F. Ord's Home Tracts; thence easterly along said westerly extension and north line to the west line of Lot 9, said Block A; thence northerly along said west line to the north line of the south half of said Lot 9; thence easterly along said north line to the west line of Lot 7, said Block A; thence northerly along said west line and along the west line of Lots 2, 3, and 6, said Block A to the northwest corner of said Lot 6; thence continuing northerly along the east line of the west 308 feet of aforesaid Tract 4, Nichol's Garden Tracts Div. No. 2 extended southerly and along said east line to the north line of said Tract 4; thence westerly along said north line and its westerly extension to the centerline of 22nd Avenue South; thence southerly along said centerline to the Point of Beginning.
