

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to the Justice Court  
2 District of King County pursuant to R.C.W.  
3 Chapters 3.30 through 3.74 stating the number  
4 of Justices to be elected in each Justice  
5 Court District; providing for the location of  
6 a central office, courtroom and records of  
7 each court; authorizing Justice Court Com-  
8 missioners when necessary; providing for de-  
9 partments into which each Justice Court shall  
10 be initially organized; providing for the name  
11 of each Justice Court District; providing for  
12 the allocation of time and salary of each  
13 Justice who serve part-time as a Municipal Judge;

24 thence Northerly along the center line of 6th Ave. Southwest to  
25 the center line of Southwest 143rd St.; thence Westerly along the  
26 center line of Southwest 143rd St. to the center line of Ambaum  
27 Road Southwest; thence Southerly along the center line of Ambaum  
28 Road Southwest to the North line of Sec. 19, said Twp. and Range;  
29 thence Westerly along said North line to the center line of 12th  
30 Ave. Southwest; thence Southerly along the center line to 12th  
31 Ave. Southwest to the center line of Southwest 148th St.; thence  
32 Westerly along the center line of Southwest 148th St. to the  
33 center line of 16th Ave. Southwest; thence Southerly along the  
center line of 16th Ave. Southwest to the center line of Southwest  
149th St.; thence Westerly along the center line of Southwest  
149th St. to the center line of 22nd Ave. Southwest; thence Nor-  
therly along the center line of 22nd Ave. Southwest to the North  
line of Sec. 24, Twp. 23 N., R. 3, E.W.M.; thence Westerly along  
the North line of said Sec. 24 and its Westerly extension to the  
center line of Puget Sound; thence Northerly along the center line  
of Puget Sound to an intersection with the Southerly line of the  
present boundary of the City of Seattle, which is the point of  
beginning, EXCEPT, any portion lying within the existing City  
limits of Seattle.

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SECTION 22. NEW SECTION. The legal boundaries of the  
Seattle Justice District Court shall be:

All of the area within the boundary of the City of  
Seattle which includes to the centerline of the waters of Puget  
Sound and the centerline of Lake Washington.

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SECTION 23. NEW SECTION. The legal boundaries of the

Shoreline Justice District Court shall be:

All of the area within the following described line:  
Beginning at the intersection of the centerline of Puget Sound with the Westerly production of the North line of Sec. 2, Twp. 26, N., R. 3, E.W.M.; thence Easterly along the North line of Sec. 2 and Sec. 1, said Twp. and Range and continuing Easterly along the North line of Secs. 6, 5, 4 and 3, Twp. 26 N., R. 4, E.W.M. to the Northeast corner of Sec. 3; thence Southerly along the east line of Secs. 3 and 10 said Twp. and Range and its Southerly production, to the centerline of Lake Washington; thence Southerly along said centerline to an intersection with the Easterly production of the South line of Sec. 15, Twp. 26 N., R. 4, E.W.M.; thence Westerly along said production and South line of Secs. 15, 16, 17 and 18, said Twp. and Range and continuing Westerly along the South line of Sec. 13, Twp. 26, N., R. 3, E.W.M., and its Westerly production, to the centerline of Puget Sound; thence Northerly along said centerline to the North line of Sec. 2, Twp. 26 N., R. 3, E.W.M., produced Westerly, which is the point of beginning.

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SECTION 24. NEW SECTION. The legal boundaries of the  
Vashon Island Justice District Court shall be:

All of Vashon and Maury Islands in Twps. 21 N., Ranges  
2 and 3, E.W.M.; Twps. 22 N., Ranges 2 and 3, E.W.M.; and Twps.  
23 N., Ranges 2 and 3, E.W.M. and the waters of Puget Sound to the  
center lines of the channels surrounding said islands.



1            SECTION 25. NEW SECTION. Resolutions No. 24130, 24428,  
2 31783, 32160, 32924, Ordinances No. 515 and 1929 and K.C.C. 2.68  
3 are hereby repealed.


4            SECTION 26. NEW SECTION. The fulltime position for the
