

ORDINANCE NO. 2159

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Burke/Cedar Downs to King County Water District No. 105.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 105 has found the petition for annexation of an area known as Burke/Cedar Downs to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan for water facilities;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 105 of the area known as Burke/Cedar Downs and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Burke/Cedar Downs to be annexed is described as follows:

All in King County Washington.

The South $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20 Township 22 North Range 6 EWM together with


1 That portion of the S ½ of Section 21 Township 22 North
2 Range 6 EWM, lying westerly of the East margin of the
3 Witte Road (aka 220th Ave. SE and 220th Place SE),


