

ORDINANCE NO. 2163

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Rustic Village to Lakehaven Sewer District.

WHEREAS, Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for an election on the annexation of an area known as Rustic Village to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires the approval of the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board before the setting of a special election to submit the proposal to the qualified electors within the territory to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan for sewer facilities, and of benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of the area known as Rustic Village and described in Section 2 herein is approved subject to results of a special election to be held within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed.

SECTION 2. The Rustic Village to be annexed is described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the South line of Section 33, Township 22 North, Range 4 East, W.M., in King County, Washington (said line also being the centerline of S. 288th St.) and the Southerly prolongation of the Westerly line of the plat of Rustic Village as recorded in Volume 65 of Plats, page 47 - 48, records of King County, Washington;

Thence Northerly along said Westerly line and its Southerly prolongation to an intersection with the Southerly line of the plat of Noffsingers Second Addition as recorded in Volume 75 of Plats, page 93, records of King County, Washington;

Thence Westerly along said South line and its Westerly prolongation to an intersection with the centerline of Military Road;

1 Thence Northeasterly along said centerline of Military
2 Road to its intersection with the East margin of
Interstate Highway No. 5;

3 Thence Southerly along the East margin of said Inter-
4 state Highway No. 5 to its intersection with the East
5 line of said Section 33 (also being the West line of
6 Section 34)

7 Thence Southerly along the East line of said Section 33
8 to the Southeast corner thereof;

9 Thence Westerly along the South line of said Section 33
10 (also being the centerline of South 288th St.) to the
11 Point of Beginning.

12 LESS the following described parcel:

13 The West half of the Southwest quarter of the Southeast
14 quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 33,
15 Township 22 North, Range 4 East W.M., King County,
16 Washington;
17 AND LESS the West 138 feet of the South 316 feet
18 thereof;
19 AND LESS the North 120 feet thereof.


20 TOGETHER WITH the West half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of Government Lot 4,
21 Section 3, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M.,
22 EXCEPT the South $\frac{1}{4}$ thereof;

23 TOGETHER WITH all that portion of Government Lot 2,
24 Section 4, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.M.,
25 lying East of the West margin of Military Road, EXCEPT
26 that portion annexed to Lakehaven Sewer District by
27 King County Resolution No. 30919.


