

ORDINANCE NO. 2181

74-779

AN ORDINANCE extending the deadline for submission of taxing district's 1975 budget to the King County Council and declaring an emergency.

PREAMBLE:

The Department of Revenue has notified the County that a computer malfunction has caused the utility certification sent to the Assessor on September 10, 1974 to be in error.

It will therefore be impossible for King County taxing districts to certify to the King County Council the amount of levies required to support them in 1975 by October 9, 1974 as required by Ordinance No. 2152.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The taxing districts of King County shall certify to the King County Council on or before October 30, 1974 the amount of levies to be made in support of their district for 1975 in total and by individual fund.


SECTION 2. The King County Assessor shall certify to the taxing districts of King County the assessed valuation of property lying within the boundaries of the district for the 1975 tax levy by October 14, 1974.

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.


