

ORDINANCE NO. 2182

1  
2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an  
3 area known as Welchko, et al to King County  
4 Water District No. 58.

5 WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 58 has found the  
6 petition for annexation of an area known as Welchko, et al to be  
7 sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed  
8 annexation; and

9 WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexa-  
10 tion by the King County Council and the King County Boundary  
11 Review Board; and

12 WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in  
13 the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county com-  
14 prehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan  
15 for water facilities;

16 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

17 SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District  
18 No. 58 of the area known as Welchko, et al and described in  
19 Section 2 herein is approved.

20 SECTION 2. The area known as Welchko, et al to be annexed  
21 is described as follows:

22 Commencing at the Northeast corner of the Southwest  
23 quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 16, Town-  
24 ship 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County,  
25 Washington;

26 Thence Westerly along the North line of said Subdivision  
27 to an intersection with a line that is 180 feet West of  
28 and parallel to the East line of the Southwest quarter  
29 of of the Southwest quarter of said Section 16, said  
30 intersection being the True Point of Beginning;

31 Thence Southerly along said parallel line to the South  
32 line of the Southwest quarter of said Section 16;

33 Thence Westerly along said South line to the Southwest  
corner of the East half of the Southwest quarter of the  
Southwest quarter of said Section 16;

Thence Northerly along the West line of said subdivision  
to the North line of the Southwest quarter of the South-  
west quarter of said Section 16;


1 Thence Easterly along said North line of said subdivision  
2 to the True Point of Beginning.

4 September, 1974.




