

ORDINANCE NO. 2209

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Security Store, et al to King County Water District No. 75.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 75 has found the petition for annexation of an area known as Security Store, et al to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan for water facilities;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 75 of the area known as Security Store, et al and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Security Store, et al to be annexed is described as follows:

S½ of the NE¼ of the NW¼ of Section 32, Township 23 North, Range 4 East, W.M., in King County, Washington.


LESS the west 230 feet thereof.


