ORDINANCE NO. 2232

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County Executive to enter into an agreement to transfer Forward Thrust funds designated for the Seattle-Marymoor Trail to the City of Mercer Island and authorizing the transfer of funds.

PREAMBLE:

King County has acquired that portion of the park facility known as Seattle-Marymoor Trail, located in unincorporated King County. A portion of the remaining trail corridor is located wholly within the City Limits of Mercer Island, Washington; and the City of Mercer Island has agreed to acquire, develop, and maintain said facility as a public park and recreational facility for the citizens of the City of Mercer Island and all King County.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County Executive is authorized to execute an agreement with the City of Mercer Island to transfer \$19,890 from the King County Park Acquisition and Development Fund to the City of Mercer Island to acquire and/or develop that portion of said trail lying wholly within their jurisdiction, as provided for in King County Resolution #34571, Section 4.

SECTION 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to transfer \$19,890 from the King County Park Acquisition and Development Fund to the City of Mercer Island for use at Seattle-Marymoor Trail.
