ORDINANCE NO. 2235

AN ORDINANCE appropriating unanticipated revenues of \$400,192 to the Arterial Highway Development Fund, to be applied toward the completion of Ambaum Blvd. & 16th Avenue Southwest (600772), amending Ordinance No. 1859 as amended, Section 7, 8 and attachment No. 1.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$400,192 from the City of Seattle, Department of Lighting to be applied toward the completion of Department of Public Works-Roads Division-Arterial Highway Development Project Number 600772 known as "Ambaum Blvd. and 16th Avenue Southwest (S.W. Roxbury St. to South 144th Street).

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 1859, Section 7 as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:


