

ORDINANCE NO. 2239

AN ORDINANCE relating to the removal of any member of any King County Board, Commission or Committee, and adding a new section to K.C.C. 2.28.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. NEW SECTION. There is hereby added to Chapter 2.28 a new section which reads as follows:


After public hearing any appointed member of any King County Board, Commission or Committee may be removed by a two-thirds vote of the County Council for inefficiency, neglect of duty, or malfeasance in office. Removal proceedings may be initiated by the County Council or County Executive or pursuant to the following provisions by the Board Commission, or Committee.

A member of any King County Board, Commission, or Committee who misses three consecutive regular meetings, or at least one half of the meetings during any six month period of the King County Board, Commission, or Committee of which he is a member without prior approval of the appropriate chairman or vice-chairman may be removed and the position declared vacant by a majority vote of the members of the Board, Commission, or Committee. The Chairman shall also submit written notification to the County Council and the County Executive of their action.




