ORDINANCE NO. 2241

AN ORDINANCE relating to establishment of 228th Avenue NE Extension (Sta. 162+00 to Redmond-Fall City Road).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation has made an examination of 228th Avenue NE Extension along the course and description set forth below and has made a favorable report upon the same, as required by R.C.W. 36.81.050.

SECTION 2: Said road shall be established not less than 84 feet in width, having 42 feet of such width each side of the following described centerline:

Beginning on the centerline of 228th Avenue NE Extension at Engineers Sta. 162+00 as surveyed by King County Survey No. 28-25-6-3 (Sur. Line "B") said Station being in Section 17, Township 25 North, Range 6 East, W.M., thence in a northerly direction a distance of 1,474.21 feet to a point of terminus on the centerline of the Redmond-Fall City Road.

(1,474.21 Feet = 0.279 Mile)

SECTION 3: King County Council finds that the establishment of said roadway, along the course and description set forth, is a public necessity.
