

ORDINANCE NO. 2246

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$65,160 to the Building Modernization Construction Fund from funds available in Special Programs, Current Expense Fund to provide funds for remodeling needed to establish a detoxification facility at United States Public Health Hospital, amending Ordinance No. 1859, Sections 7 and 8, and Attachment No. 1, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation in the amount of \$65,160 to the Building Modernization Construction Fund from funds available in Special Programs, Current Expense Fund to provide needed remodeling in support of the establishment of a detoxification facility is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 1859, Section 8, Attachment No. 1, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:


