

ORDINANCE NO. 2267

AN ORDINANCE defining the allocation of Federal Shared Revenue Funds by entitlement, amending Ordinance No. 1859, Section 3, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that Federal Shared Revenue Funds have been allocated as shown in Attachment 1 herewith including 1974 receipts \$401,135 in excess of estimates.






