ORDINANCE NO. 2270

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Highline School District #401 to King County Water District #75.

WHEREAS, King County Water District #75 has found the petition for annexation of an area known as Highline School District #401 to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan for water facilities;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District #75 of the area known as Highline School District #401 and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Highline School District #401 to be annexed is described as follows:

That portion of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 32, T. 23 N., R 4 E. W.M., in King County, Washington, lying Westerly of the West Margin of SR 509.
