and plumbing systems and amending Resolution No. 28817 as amended by Ordinance No. 1220, and Chapter 16.32 of the King County Code.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE KING COUNTY COUNCIL:

Section 1. Section 16.32.320 of the King County Code and Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1220 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Permit Required:

- It is unlawful to do any work on any plumbing system without a Plumbing Permit as required by this resolution; except the repair or replacement of a plumbing fixture; the repair or replacement of a valve or faucet in a water supply system; the clearance of stoppages, the stopping of leaks; or the repair or replacement of domestic hot water tanks.
- Application for a Plumbing Permit shall be made to the Director of Public Health and shall give the nature of the work, the number and kind of fixtures to be installed, and such other reasonable information as the Director of Public Health may require.
- Application for a plumbing permit shall be accompanied by the following fees:

Minimum fee for issuing each permit \$3.00 \$5.00 For each plumbing fixture or trap or set of fixtures on one trap (including water drainage vent piping and backflow protection therefor) \$±.75 \$2.50

1	For each atmospheric vacuum breaker in irrigation systems, tanks, vats, etc.
2	or for installation on unprotected plumbing fixtures including necessary
3	water piping One (1) to five (5)
5	Over five (5) - each \$50 \$1.00 Pressure type backflow preventer - each \$10.00
6	
7	Reduced pressure principle backflow prevention device - each \$10.00
3	Annual reinspection fee for reduced pressure backflow prevention device - each \$10.00
9	For the purpose of this section, a fixture shall mean and
10	include any appliance which is connected with a water, drain or
11	vent pipe, but no sillcock faucet or hose bib shall be consi-
12	dered a fixture.
13	(d) Fees for miscellaneous inspection services:
14	Fees for inspection service outside regular working hours
15	or for inspection service requested but not covered by a permit
16	will be charged for at a rate equal to the cost of performing
17	the service.
18	Fee for permanent location inspection of
19	factory housing (Minimum fee charged for plumbing only). No added fee for gas
20	piping meter connection with original plumbing inspection per single family
21	dwelling
22	service and gas meter connection)
23	Additional plumbing fixtures roughed in after factory housing or mobile home is
24	permanently located on foundation - each - \$1.75 \$2.50
25	(e) Every Plumbing Permit shall be posted on the building
26	or premises where the work permitted is being done and shall not
27	be removed until the work has been finally approved by the
28	Director of Public Health.
