

ORDINANCE NO. 2302

64 - 964

AN ORDINANCE relating to For-Hire Driver's; amending Ordinance 1120, Section 31 and K.C.C. 6.64.310.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1120, Section 31 and K.C.C. 6.64.310 are hereby amended as follows:

Qualifications for a for-hire driver's license. No person shall be issued a for-hire driver's license unless he possesses the following qualifications:

(A) Must be at least eighteen years of age;

(B) Must be a bona fide resident of the state of Washington for at least six months prior to filing application;

(C) Must possess a valid state of Washington Motor Vehicle Operator's License;

(D) Must be free from any infirmity of body or mind which would render the applicant unfit for safe operation of a motor vehicle and shall have submitted to a medical examination by ~~((the Seattle-King County health department))~~ a licensed physician and ~~((have obtained))~~ file with the director a certificate from ((the officer)) said physician certifying his fitness as such for-hire driver: The scope of the examination and the certificate form shall be prescribed by the Seattle-King County health department. Such examination ~~((certificate))~~ shall not be required for renewals of such license, but the director may at any time at his discretion require any licensee to be so examined and to secure such a certificate or renewal thereof;

(E) Must not be addicted to the use of intoxicating liquor,
dangerous drugs or narcotics.
