AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$1,243,134 to the CETA Title VI Fund, and amending Ordinance No. 2230, Section 87.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$1,243,134 is hereby approved and adopted to the CETA Title VI Fund from a grant for the period January 1, 1975 through December 31, 1975.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2230, Section 87, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows : From the CETA Title VI Fund there is hereby appropriated ((~~\$619,764~~)) \$1,862,898

PROVIDED THAT:

- 1) These funds shall be expended only for expenses of administration and operation of the CETA Title VI fund of participating local jurisdictions other than King County ((.)) except as otherwise authorized by motion of the Council.

SECTION 3. Attachment 1 specifies the allocation of this appropriation by County and non-County agency.

4. Is the work to be performed by the position of a one-time or special nature, and once this task is accomplished, will there no longer be any need for the position and/or can the position be absorbed from another funding source other than current expense.
5. Is the position requested to perform a special high priority task of the Executive or Council and could not be funded from other sources during development of the 1975 budget.
6. Is the position one which will be permanent in nature and will eventually become an obligation for normal funding.
