

1 AN ORDINANCE relating to Rules and Order of Business
 2 of the King County Council, amending Ord. 1420, Sec. 2,
 3 Ord. 1482, Sec. 1, Ord. 1373, Sec. 17, and K.C.C.1.24.170.

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 5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

6 SECTION 1. Ordinance 1420, Section 2, Ordinance 1482, Section 1,
 7 Ordinance 1373, Section 17, and K.C.C. 1.24.170 are hereby amended as follows:

8 Standing committees. The chairman of the council shall appoint the
 9 chairman, vice chairman and the membership of the standing committees, with
 10 consent of a majority of the council members.

11 The standing committees are established as follows:

12 (1) (~~Health-and-Safety~~) Health and Human Services - Four or More
 13 Members. Function: to consider and make recommendations on all matters
 14 relating to health, welfare, (~~police-and-fire-protection,-air-and-water~~
 15 ~~pollution,-and-civil-defense,-and-on-all-matters-concerning-building-permits,~~
 16 ~~building-codes,-and-other-technical-codes-and-regulations~~) and human resource
 17 programs of the county including human service functional planning and
 18 programming.

19 (2) (~~Community-and-Environmental-Development~~) Planning and Community
 20 Development - Five Members. Function: to consider and make recommendations on
 21 all matters pertaining to (~~comprehensive-plans,-urban-renewal-and-zoning-~~
 22 ~~within-the-County,-on-matters-pertaining-to-County-parks-and-other-recreational~~
 23 ~~facilities-and-program-and-public-open-space-and-related-public-community~~
 24 ~~service~~) comprehensive planning within the County, including long range and
 25 community plans, functional plans for housing, parks and recreation,
 26 transportation, economic development, shoreline management, open space, air
 27 and water quality; to consider and report on all matters pertaining to zoning
 28 and other land use development controls.

29 (3) (~~Budget-and-Long-Range-Planning~~) Finance, Audit and Budget -
 30 Four or More Members. Function: to recommend budget objectives and priorities
 31 and schedule for the Council's review of the yearly Executive budget proposal;
 32 to consider and make recommendations on all matters and legislation of a
 33 financial nature, including appropriations, expenditures (~~and~~), the selling

1 of bonds and investment policies; and on all matters relating to the levying
2 of taxes; to investigate and report on all financial claims filed against
3 the county; to examine requests for changes in assessments and taxes; to
4 receive and examine reports of the County and State Auditor and submit such
5 recommendations to the County Council as it deems necessary or desirable in
6 connection with the subject matter of such reports; and coordinate Council
7 overview of the economy, efficiency and effectiveness of all County
8 departments and programs.

9 (4) Inter-Governmental Relations - Four or More Members. Function: to
10 consider and make recommendations on all matters of joint interest between
11 ((the-county-and-federal-government,-state-of-Washington,-cities-and
12 municipalities-within-the-county,-other-counties,-and-other-governmental
13 agencies)) the County and (a) other counties, the state of Washington and the
14 federal government, (b) the city of Seattle and other towns and municipalities
15 within the county, and (c) other government agencies such as Metro, the Puget
16 Sound Council of Governments and Central Puget Sound Economic Development
17 District.

18 (5) ((Operations-and-Judiciary)) Operations, Police and Judiciary -
19 Four or More Members. Function: to consider and make recommendations on matters
20 relating to ((salaries,-wages,-and-working-conditions-of-County-employees;))
21 county personnel and governmental organization; ((to-investigate-and-report
22 upon-the-efficiency-of-all-County-departments-and-the-operations-development
23 thereof;)) to oversee and receive reports from the Office of Citizens'
24 Complaints ((and-the-County-Auditor)); to consider and make recommendations on
25 all matters relating to County records and elections; to consider and make
26 recommendations on all matters relating to amendment of the County Charter;
27 to consider and make recommendations on all matters relating to the criminal
28 justice system, including law, safety, and justice, functional planning and
29 programming.

30 (6) ((Public Works and Transportation)) Public Facilities and Utilities -
31 Four or More Members. Function: to consider and make recommendations on all
32 matters ((pertaining)) relating to the construction and maintenance of the
33 County road and park system, ((and-other-transportation-facilities;)) and on


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all matters ((~~pertaining to other County construction, solid waste, public works, and utilities~~)) concerning public facilities, solid waste, surface water, fire protection and utilities, including public facilities and utilities to consider and make recommendations on all matters concerning building permits, building codes and other technical codes and regulations.


