ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to Emergency Medical Services; defining the responsibilities of the Division of Emergency Medical Services within the King County Department of Health and Social Services; and amending Ordinance 1596, and K.C.C. 8.64.020.

PREAMBLE:

The Council of King County finds that there is a need to improve the quality and quantity of emergency medical services in King County. Further, the Council of King County finds that there is a need to supplement the King County fire service districts in providing advanced life support skills.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1596, and K.C.C. 8.64.020 are hereby amended as follows:

The Division of Emergency Medical Services shall:

- 1. Analyze the emergency medical needs and disaster response capabilities of the county;
- 2. Set standards for the training and examination of emergency medical service personnel, equipment and facilities in the county including, but not limited to, public education, communication and response capabilities, transportation of the sick and injured, and emergency facilities;
- 3. Coordinate all aspects of emergency medical services in King County with federal and state governments, other counties, municipalities and special districts;
- 4. Receive and dispense federal, state and local funds for the purpose of improving the quality and quantity of emergency medical services in King County;
- 5. Implement emergency medical services training programs, public information procedures and/or delivery systems;
- 6. Provide planning resources for emergency medical services and disaster responses for King County and local jurisdictions;
