

ORDINANCE NO. 2375

1  
2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an  
3 area known as Virginia Street to Lakehaven  
4 Sewer District.

5 WHEREAS, Lakehaven Sewer District has found the petition for  
6 an election on the annexation of an area known as Virginia Street  
7 to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the  
8 proposed annexation; and

9 WHEREAS, state law requires the approval of the King County  
10 Council and the King County Boundary Review Board before the  
11 setting of a special election to submit the proposal to the  
12 qualified electors within the territory to be annexed; and

13 WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in  
14 the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county  
15 comprehensive plan, the basinwide sewer plan, and the county plan  
16 for sewer facilities, and of benefit to the land included within  
17 the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed;

18 THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

19 SECTION 1. The annexation by Lakehaven Sewer District of  
20 the area known as Virginia Street and described in Section 2  
21 herein is approved subject to results of a special election to be  
22 held within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be  
23 annexed.

24 SECTION 2. The Virginia Street to be annexed is described  
25 as follows:

26 That portion of the South 1/2 of the Southwest quarter  
27 of the Northeast quarter of Section 12, Township 21  
28 North, Range 3 East, W.M., King County, Washington;  
29 and

30 That portion of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest  
31 quarter of said Section 12, lying East of the  
32 centerline of Dumas Avenue (S. S. Hwy. No. I-V) and

1 That portion of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest  
2 quarter of said Section 12, lying East of the  
centerline of Dumas Avenue (S. S. Hwy. No. I-V).
