

ORDINANCE NO. 2378

2 AN ORDINANCE approving and adopting collec-
3 tive bargaining agreements negotiated by
4 and between King County and certain labor
5 organizations; establishing the effective
6 date of said agreements; and repealing
7 Ordinance No. 1473 and Ordinance No. 1958.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

10 SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 1473 and Ordinance No. 1958 are
11 each hereby repealed.

12 SECTION 2. Approval and adoption is hereby made of the
13 collective bargaining agreements attached hereto and by this
14 reference made a part hereof negotiated by and between King County
15 and the following labor organizations:

18 Joint Crafts

19 Offset Workers, Printing Pressman & Assistants Union,

32 SECTION 3. The effective date of the agreements/wage
33 reopeners set forth in SECTION 1 herein shall be January 1, 1975.

34 SECTION 4. The compensation to be paid employees represented
35 by Public Safety Employees, Local 519, whose collective
36 bargaining agreement is not included in SECTION 1 hereof shall be

1 12 per cent greater than the rates set forth by position title
2 in said collective bargaining agreement adopted by Ordinance 1958
3 and in effect as of December 31, 1974, and shall remain so until
4 such time as the arbitration award pursuant to R.C.W. 41.56.460
5 has been handed down and the effective date thereof established
6 by ordinance.

7 SECTION 5. The authority of the County Executive to correct
8 clerical errors pursuant to the procedures outlined in Ordinance
9 No. 465 shall be and is hereby extended to include the 1975
10 budget and any salary and/or appropriation ordinances enacted
11 pursuant thereto.

12 Section 6. Nothing herein shall limit the authority of the
13 Manager, Division of Personnel, to reclassify any County officer
14 or employee's position title and to establish salary payment
15 procedures pursuant to Ordinance No. 422 and the "Administrative
16 Procedures and Rules for the Career Service" approved
17 March 13, 1974.
