

ORDINANCE NO. 2412

1
2 AN ORDINANCE relating to setting a date of
3 election for annexation of territory to
4 Lakehaven Sewer District known as Virginia
5 Street.

6 PREAMBLE:

7 The requirements of RCW 56.24.070 and RCW 36.93.090,
8 36.93.093 and 36.93.100 for annexation of territory to
9 a sewer district have been fulfilled by Lakehaven Sewer
10 District.

11 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

12 SECTION 1. The proposed annexation of territory known as
13 Virginia Street to Lakehaven Sewer District will be conducive to
14 the public health, welfare and convenience and will be of special
15 benefit to the land included within the boundaries of the
16 territory proposed to be annexed.

17 SECTION 2. A special election shall be held on the 5th
18 day of August, 1975, within the territory of the
19 proposed annexation as hereinafter described, between the hours
20 of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m., for the purpose of
21 submitting to the qualified electors within the territory
22 proposed to be annexed the proposition of annexing said territory
23 to Lakehaven Sewer District.

24 SECTION 3. The boundaries of the territory to be annexed to
25 Lakehaven Sewer District are hereby described as follows:

26 That portion of the South 1/2 of the Southwest quarter
27 of the Northeast quarter of Section 12, Township 21
28 North, Range 3 East, W.M., King County, Washington;
29 and

30 That portion of the Southeast quarter of the northwest
31 quarter of said Section 12, lying East of the
32 centerline of Dumas Avenue (S. S. Hwy. No. I-V) and

33 That portion of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest
quarter of said Section 12, lying East of the
centerline of Dumas Avenue (S. S. Hwy. No. I-V).

SECTION 4. In submitting said proposition to the voters for
their approval or rejection, the proposition shall be expressed

1 on the ballot in the following terms:

2 For Annexation to Lakehaven Sewer District

3 Against Annexation to Lakehaven Sewer District

4 SECTION 5. Notice of election shall be published as
5 required by law.

7 June, 1975.
